



Forestry Education & Training Scholarship APPLICATION FORM - 2019

Three **Forestry Education & Training Scholarships** of up to \$1,500 each are available to British Columbians pursuing forestry-related post-secondary education or technical training during the 2019/20 school year. This includes forestry-specific training, as well as trades training leading to a job within the forest industry. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, technology / books, or work gear.

Requirements for Eligibility

- You must be a resident of British Columbia.
- You must be pursuing post-secondary or technical training at an accredited institution in BC during the 2019/20 school year. This can include education in a forestry program or technical training in a trades program leading to a job in the forestry.

Application Instructions

1. To apply, prepare an application package that includes:
 - A completed application form (pages 2-4 of this document).
 - One letter of recommendation. This could be from a teacher, coach, or employer, or someone else who knows you well. It cannot be a family member.

Scholarships will be awarded by the Forestry Friendly Communities committee. The successful candidates will be those who meet eligibility criteria and who best demonstrate a commitment to pursuing a forestry-related career through answers to application questions.

Proof of enrollment will be required before funds are issued.
